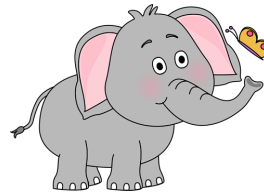

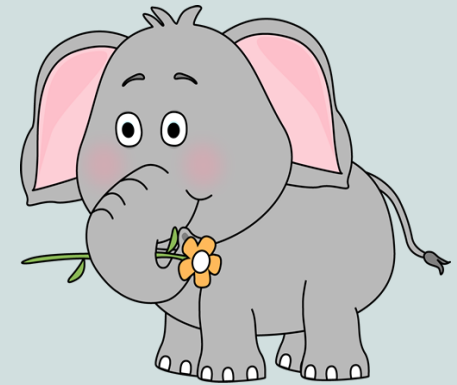

Individual ERIC tokens are given to the children in school for showing any of the ERIC values.

These can be awarded to the children by any adult in the school

These tokens are put onto the class Eric Rewards chart.

Each week the tokens are counted and the class with the most amount of ERIC tokens keep the ERIC cuddly toy for the week. The class also gets a point .

At the end of the term the points are counted up and the class with the most points get a treat, encouraging team work.

When your child achieves all targets in an area they are given a star in assembly to take home.

I know what to do if I am stuck, before asking an adult.

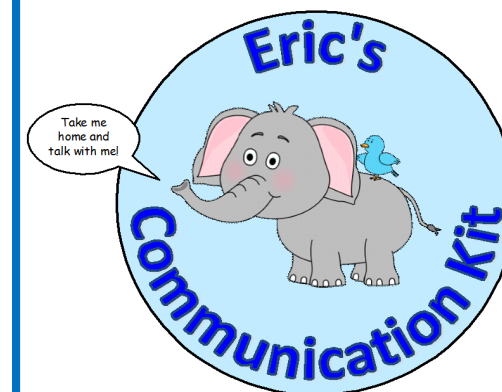
I can choose the best equipment to do my work and put it away.
