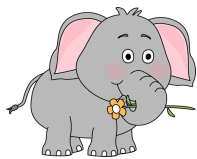
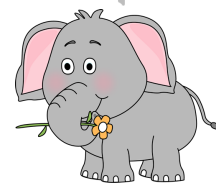

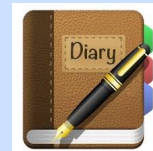

The children thoroughly enjoyed their fun run and raised a fantastic £606.50 of extra funds for our school outdoors areas and calm area.

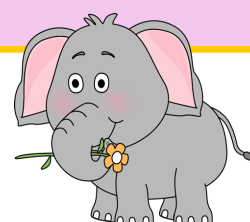
Fathers day gift shop is Tuesday 13th June, more information to follow.
